CRM (A) 2020 of 2022

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Margram** P.S. Case No. **52 of 2022** dated **12/03/2022** under Sections **448/323/325/354/313/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Considering the nature of injury suffered by the victim and considering the materials in the case diary, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner no.1 (*Morjina Khatun @ Bibi*) and the petitioner no.2 (*Nurmina Khatun*) shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer and the petitioner no.3 (*Ritan Sekh*) and the petitioner no.4 (*Minarul Sekh*) will report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of

the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM (A) 2020 of 2022 is, thus disposed of.
