A direction to secure expeditious disposal of a matrimonial suit (MAT Suit No.50 of 2020) pending before the learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track Court, Kalyani, Nadia is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

As per submission disclosed by the learned advocate for the petitioner, no interlocutory application is pending before the Court below requiring decision to be rendered.

The only contention expressed by the learned advocate for the petitioner is against the delay caused in the disposal of suit. No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite party is thus dispensed with.

Accordingly, the learned Additional District Judge, Fast Track Court, Kalyani, Nadia in MAT Suit No.50 of 2020 is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of pending suit, referred hereinabove, after causing disposal of interlocutory applications, if there be any pending, providing sufficient opportunities of hearing to either of the parties of this case, but without granting unnecessary adjournment, unless it is

extremely unavoidable.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned Court below as well as to the learned advocate appearing in the Court below for the opposite party and opposite party.

With this observation and direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
