In Re: - An application for bail under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed in connection with **Taherpur** Police Station Case No. **13** of **2022** dated **10.01.2022** under Sections **448/325/326/307/392** adding Sections **412/413** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

Petitioner prays for bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that in the charge-sheet as against the petitioner, it is alleged that the petitioner received the stolen mobile phones.

Learned advocate appearing for the State draws the attention of the Court to the materials in the case diary.

Considering the fact that the police filed charge-sheet and considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ranaghat, Nadia subject to the condition that during bail he shall appear before the learned trial court on every date of hearing and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to comply with the conditions as enshrined hereinbefore, it is open to the trial court to cancel the bail without any further reference to this Court.

The application for bail being **CRM (DB) 1256 of 2022** is, thus, disposed of.
