Petitioner prays for anticipatory bail.

Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the police complaint was lodged after 24 days of the incident.

Learned advocate appearing for the State submits that the victim suffered fracture injury. He refers to the materials in the case diary.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein and the fact that victim suffered fracture injury, we are not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **rejected**.
