In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Karimpur** P.S. Case No. **104/2022** dated **05/05/2022** under Sections **448/323/354A/380/427/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Considering the fact that there is no injury report of any of the victim in the case diary and considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we are grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner no.1 (*Mannya Halder @ Manya*), petitioner no.2 (*Provat Halder*) and petitioner no.3 (*Niliu Halder*) will report before the Investigating Officer once in a month and the petitioner no.4 (*Manju Halder @ Munju Halder*) shall co-operate with the Investigating Officer and on condition that the petitioners shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the

date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM (A) 2167 of 2022 is, thus disposed of.
