C.R.M. (A) 2225 of 2022

In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Nakashipara** P.S. Case No.**97 of 2022** dated **20/02/2022** under Sections **447/325/326/34** of the Indian Penal Code.

And

Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

In view of the first petitioner, namely, Sanjay Ghosh, being arrested, **C.R.M. (A) 2225 of 2022** is dismissed as not pressed on his behalf.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the other petitioner therein and considering the nature of injury suffered by the victim, we grant anticipatory bail to the second petitioner, namely, Jothsna Ghosh.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner no.2, namely, Jothsna Ghosh, shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner no.2, namely, Jothsna Ghosh, will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioner no.2, namely, Jothsna Ghosh, shall appear every day

before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner no.2, namely, Jothsna Ghosh, in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner no.2, namely, Jothsna Ghosh, is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 2225 of 2022 is disposed of.
