Mr. Lalratan Mondal, learned advocate appears for the petitioners.

Record shows that the notice of this application has not been served on the opposite parties.

The petitioners by filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India have prayed for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No. 18657 of 2014(SI No. 292 of 2014), pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 7th Court at Alipore.

The learned advocate for the petitioners submits that the learned Court below has been granting unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is a delay in disposal of the case and such delay is causing hardship to the petitioners.

Having regard to the nature of relief claimed by the petitioners, being a prayer for expeditious disposal of the title suit, I do not find any need to serve notice of the present application on the opposite parties and it is not likely to cause any prejudice to the interest of the opposite parties. Therefore, service of notice upon the opposite parties is dispensed with.

The learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 7th Court at Alipore, is requested to dispose of the Title Suit No. 18657 of 2014(SI No. 292 of 2014), as expeditiously as possible and in any event, within a period of one year from the date of communication of this order, without granting any adjournment whatsoever to any of the parties, as the suit is pending since 2014.

Accordingly, the revisional application being **C.O. 1138 of 2021** is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
