It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that the victim died due to snake bite.

Learned advocate appearing for the State produces the case diary.

We have considered the statements of witnesses which corroborate the submission of the petitioners. That apart, no post-mortem was conducted to determine the cause of death. Under such circumstances, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioners may not be necessary in the facts of the present case and they may be granted anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners, namely **(1) Ananda Chowdhury @ Ananda Mohan & (2) Arati Chowdhury**, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the

petitioners shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
