Petitioner is in custody for more than 60 days. It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that he has been falsely implicated in the instant case.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record including statements of witnesses as well as the injury report. Injuries transpiring from the report appears to be simple in nature. Under such circumstances and bearing in the mind the period of detention already suffered, we are of the opinion further detention and progress of investigation are not necessary and petitioner may be granted bail

Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM, Bishnupur, Bankura on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing and shall not

intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event he fails to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail automatically without reference to this court.

The application being CRM(DB) No.1403 of 2022 is disposed of.
