Having considered the materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submission that victim was a major lady at the time of cohabitation and was aware of consequences thereof, we are of the opinion in the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of detention suffered by the petitioner i. e. 9 months, he may be granted bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned ACJM Barrackpore on condition that the petitioner shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event he fails to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail automatically without reference to this court.

The application being CRM(DB) No.1503 of 2022 is disposed of.
