**C. R. M. (A) 2540 of 2022**

In Re: An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure filed on 06.06.2022 in connection with Bagdah Police Station Case No. 342 of 2022 dated 12.05.2022 under Sections 498A/406/306/34 of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act. (G.R. Case No.1557 of 2022)

We have considered the materials on record. Victim-housewife committed suicide after seven years of marriage at her parental home. Keeping in mind the aforesaid facts and the extent of complicity of the petitioners, who are the in-laws of the victim-housewife, in the alleged crime, we are of the opinion custodial interrogation of the accused/petitioners may not be necessary in the facts of the present case and they may be granted anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the accused/petitioners, namely **(1) Ripon Ghosh, (2) Kanchan Ghosh, (3) Sonali Ghosh, (4) Lakshmirani Ghosh & (5) Nimai Ghosh**, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure,

1973 and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear before the court below and pray for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application for anticipatory bail is, thus, disposed of.
