A direction to secure expeditious disposal of Title Suit No. 71 of 2013, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 2nd Court, Contai, Purba Medinipur is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

The only contention expressed by the learned advocate for the petitioner is against the delay caused in the disposal of suit.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of the order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary upon the opposite parties.

Service of notice of this application upon opposite parties stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 2nd Court, Contai, Purba Medinipur, in Title Suit No. 71 of 2013 is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of pending suit, after causing disposal of interlocutory applications, if there be any pending, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing

to either of the parties to this case, but without granting unnecessary adjournments, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned court below as well as to the learned advocate appearing in the court below for the opposite parties and the opposite parties.

With this observation and direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
