We have considered the materials on record. It is contended allegations against the petitioners, who are in the in-laws of the victim-housewife, are general and omnibus in nature. In view of the aforesaid submission, period of detention suffered by the petitioners i.e. 91 days and as investigation is complete, we are of the opinion further detention of the accused/petitioners is not necessary.

Therefore, the accused/petitioners, namely **(1) Anil Patra, (2) Sandhya Patra @ Sandipa Patra & (3) Hemanta Patra**, be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bishnupur, Bankura subject to condition that the said petitioners shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event they fail to appear before the trial court without justifiable cause, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel their bail automatically without reference to this court.

The application for bail, thus, stands **allowed**.
