**C.R.M. (A) 2604 of 2022**

Petitioner is a distant relation of the husband of the victim housewife. She used to reside in Kolkata while the couple resided in Chadah, Nadia.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having considered materials on record and bearing in mind the extent of complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime in view of fact that the petitioner did not ordinarily reside at the matrimonial home of the victim, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioner shall appear before the court below and prays for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM (A) 2604 of 2022 is disposed of.
