A direction to secure expeditious disposal of Title Appeal No.88 of 2016, arising out of Misc. Case No.37 of 2019, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division) 2nd Court, Krishnagar, at Nadia, is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

The only contention expressed by the learned advocate for the petitioners is against the delay caused in the disposal of Misc. Case. No other point is raised, requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite parties stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 2nd Court, Krishnagar, at Nadia, is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of Title Appeal No.88 of 2016, after causing disposal of Misc.Case No.37 of 2019,

providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

Petitioners are directed to make communication of this order to the learned court below as well as to the opposite parties and their learned advocate in the court below.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
