Petitioners renew their prayer for bail.

Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that they are in custody for more than one year and ten months.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Petitioners were identified in the course of test identification parade and stolen articles were recovered from their possession.

In view of the aforesaid incriminating materials and as their prayer for bail was rejected earlier, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioners.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.

Trial court is requested to conclude the trial at the earliest without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either of the parties.
