Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he is in custody for one year and seven months. He renews his prayer for bail.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes prayer for bail. He submits that bail prayer of the petitioner was rejected earlier by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court.

We have considered the materials on record. Statements of witnesses implicate the petitioner in the crime. Postmortem report also indicates fracture of bone and a nearly continuous ligature mark.

In view of the aforesaid facts, we are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
