This is a contempt application under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India filed by the petitioner on 16th July, 2003 seeking punishments of the alleged contemnors for violation of the order dated 26th August, 2002 passed in WP 11567 (W) of 2002.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that he has no instruction in this matter. However, the court may dismiss the contempt application as non-prosecution.

I find that since filing of the contempt application on 16th July, 2003, no effective step was taken on behalf of the petitioner to press the application.

In view of the above, the contempt application is dismissed as not pressed.
