It is submitted on behalf of the petitioners that there was a civil dispute over collection of water from a tap.

Learned lawyer for the State opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having considered materials on record and bearing in mind the nature of allegations in the light of the submissions made on behalf of the petitioner and as injuries do not appear to be grievous, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs. 10,000/- each with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

Petitioners shall appear before the court below and prays for regular bail within four weeks from date.

The application being CRM (A) 2759 of 2022 is disposed of.
