Learned advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that in a case under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, the present case is pending for a considerable period of time without any progress, although plea (examination under Section 251 of the Code of Criminal Procedure) has been completed. Learned advocate submits that the next date has been fixed on 27.06.2022 for evidence.

Accordingly, the learned trial court is directed to fix at least one date in each and every 45 days so that the trial of the case can be taken to its logical conclusion within a reasonable period of time. No unnecessary adjournment should be granted to either of the parties. All efforts should be taken to adhere to the legislative intent as is provided under Section 143(3) of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

With the aforesaid observations, the revisional application being CRR 1949 of 2022 is disposed of.

All pending connected applications, if any, are consequently disposed of.
