Learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner prays for bail. He submits that the petitioner was earlier on bail but his bail was cancelled by a coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM 6697 of 2020. Since then, he is in custody for 162 days. Co-accuseds are on bail.

Learned Counsel appearing for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that three persons died. Bullet recovered from the body of one of the victims matches with the firearm recovered from the petitioner.

We have considered the materials on record. There are prima facie materials connecting the petitioner in the gruesome murder of three persons.

In view of gravity of the offence and prima facie involvement of the petitioner therein, we are of the opinion in view of gravity of the offence this is not a fit case to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

The application for bail is, thus, rejected.
