Mr. Amitesh Banerjee, Senior Advocate  
representing the State, submits that the report of the  
Cyber Forensics & Digital Evidence Examiner's  
Laboratory, Criminal Investigation Department is ready  
and has been sent to the Deputy Commissioner of Police  
(DCP) on 28<sup>th</sup> February 2022.

It is expected that the DCP shall conclude the  
enquiry as expeditiously as possible preferably within a  
period of one month from date and suitable orders shall  
be passed within the aforesaid time.

It is expected that the consequential and  
remedial action shall also be taken thereafter.

With the aforesaid observations, the writ petition  
is disposed of.

In view of the dismissal of the main writ petition, connected applications, if any, shall also stand dismissed.
