Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail.

Considering the nature of injuries suffered and considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and also subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner nos.1, 2, 5 and 6, namely, Akbar Mondal, Fulchand Mondal alias Golam, Momin Sekh alias Momin Sk and Kabir Mondal will report before the Investigating Officer once a month till the conclusion of the investigation and petitioner nos. 3 and 4, namely, Gulnagar Mondal alias Gulnagar Mondal and Nachira Bibi Mondal alias Nachhila Sk. will cooperate with the investigation till the conclusion of the

investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear every day before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default, the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

The prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 2861 of 2022 is disposed of.
