A direction to secure expeditious disposal of a suit for eviction filed by the petitioners/plaintiffs in the year 2008 (Ejectment Suit No.152 of 2008) of learned Judge 3rd Bench, Presidency Small Causes Court, Calcutta, is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite party stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Judge, 3rd Bench, Presidency Small Causes Court, at Calcutta, in Ejectment Suit No.152 of 2008, is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of a pending suit referred above, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
