The police authorities will keep a vigil in order to ensure neither party commits any nuisance or breach of peace.

The other issues with regard to the right, title and interest of the parties, shall be decided by the appropriate court.

This order shall not prevent the police authorities from proceeding in accordance with law, if any further untoward incident occurs, in future.

The writ petition is disposed of.

There shall be no order as to costs.
