That apart, the police took steps under Section 107/116(c) of the Cr.P.C. upon receiving a compliant.

Learned advocate appearing for the private respondent submits that there is civil suit pending and that the petitioner sold the property.

In such circumstances, it cannot be said that there is deliberate or willful violation of the order of the High Court.

Hence, CPAN 577 of 2021 is disposed of.
