A direction to secure expeditious disposal of Suit for specific performance being Title Suit No. 72 of 2004 pending before the learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 5th Court, Alipore is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

The only contention expressed by the learned advocate for the petitioner is against the delay caused in the disposal of suit.

In view of the nature of the order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary upon the opposite parties.

Service of notice of this application upon opposite parties stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 5th Court, Alipore in Title Suit No. 72 of 2004 is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of the pending suit referred hereinabove, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the

parties to this case, subject to his suitability and convenience, but without granting unnecessary adjournments, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned court below as well as to the learned advocate appearing in the court below for the opposite parties and the opposite parties.

With this observation and direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
