Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that since the petitioners are challenging the vesting of land, the same should appear before the learned Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State supports such contention and submits that this Court now does not have the jurisdiction to deal with the matter and the matter ought to be transferred to the learned Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal.

Accordingly, let the application be transferred to the learned Land Reforms and Tenancy Tribunal.
