This writ petition has been filed by three petitioners having separate causes of action. All the three petitioners could not have joined together in filing the instant writ petition. The writ petition is deemed to have been dismissed in respect of the petitioner nos. 2 and 3.

The petitioner No. 1 claims that she appeared in the TET 2012 Examination but till now the respondents failed to call the petitioner for interview and to inform whether the petitioner was successful or not.

There is no occasion to entertain the writ petition.

The writ petition fails and is hereby dismissed.
