A direction to secure expeditious disposal of Ejectment Suit No.180 of 2010, pending before the learned Judge, 6th Bench, Presidency Small Causes Court, at Calcutta is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite party stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned Judge, 6th Bench, Presidency Small Causes Court, at Calcutta, in Ejectment Suit No.180 of 2010, is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of the suit, after causing disposal of pending interlocutory application, if there be any, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
