Considering the nature of injury suffered by the victim and the statement recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the gravity of the offence and involvement of the petitioners therein, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that petitioner no.1 (Mima Bibi) and petitioner no. 4 (Foujiya Khatun) will cooperate with the investigation and petitioner no.2 (Juber Khan) and petitioner no.3 (Kashem Khan) will report before the Investigating Officer once in a fortnight till the conclusion of investigation and on further condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance

of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

CRM (A) 3160 of 2022 is disposed of.
