The subject matter of the present revisional application relates to Rabindra Sarobar Police Station Case No.105/19 (corresponding to C.G.R. No.1681/19) under Sections 341/323/379/506/509/34 of the Indian Penal Code and compromise has been effected between the parties or is being progressed before the civil court subject to the final decree of the civil court, I am of the opinion that further continuance of Rabindra Sarobar Police Station Case No.105/19 corresponding to C.G.R.
