I have perused the order passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Howrah which reflects the assessment of facts as well as the law relating to the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***Priyanka Srivastava & Anr. Vs. State of Uttar Pradesh & Ors.*** reported in ***(2015) 6 SCC 287***. Considering the nature of assessment made as well as the reasons so assigned, I am of the opinion that no interference is called for.

Accordingly, the revisional application being CRR 2038 of 2018 is dismissed.
