Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the husband was arrested and is in custody. The petitioners were falsely implicated.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention to the injury report of the victim as also to the complaint lodged by the victim.

Apparently, there was an attempt to strangle the victim. This inference can be drawn from the injury report of the victim.

The complaint of the victim paints an alarming picture. It implicates the petitioners.

In such circumstances, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.

CRM (A) 3212 of 2022 is dismissed.
