This revisional application has been filed under Section 401/482 of the Cr.P.C. assailing an order dated 9.4.2015 passed by learned Metropolitan Magistrate, 19th Court, Calcutta in Complaint Case No. CS 412279 of 2014 under Sections 192/193/195A/196/197/200/209/211/420/120B of the IPC where summons were directed to be issued only under Section 420/120B of the IPC.

Since the petitioner has not taken steps on consecutive dates, the revisional application is dismissed for default.
