A direction to secure expeditious disposal of Title Suit No. 48 of 2020 of learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 2nd Court, Ranaghat, Nadia, is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of the order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary upon the opposite party.

Service of notice of this application upon opposite party stands dispensed with.

Accordingly, the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 2nd Court, Ranaghat, Nadia, in Title Suit No. 48 of 2020 is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of the suit, after adhering to the provisions of the law, subject to suitability and convenience, of Court below without causing deprivation of the other litigants similarly circumstanced, but without granting unnecessary adjournments, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of

this order to the learned court below as well as to the learned advocate appearing in the court below for the opposite party and the opposite party.

With this observation and direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
