Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

The application for anticipatory bail is taken up for consideration subsequent to the order dated July 13, 2022.

The Registrar General by a report dated July 18, 2022 states that a sum of Rs.2,14,000/- was deposited with the petitioner.

In such circumstances, considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioner therein and considering the fact that the petitioner deposited a sum of Rs.2,14,000/- with the Registrar General of this Court in terms of the order dated July 13, 2022, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer as and when called for till the conclusion of the investigation and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear on

every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is allowed.

CRM (A) 3329 of 2022 is disposed of.
