Petitioner is in custody for 7 years 6 months 10 days.

There is slow progress in the trial.

Learned advocate for the State submits that date has been fixed for recording remaining prosecution witnesses on and from 9th September, 2022.

We have considered the materials on record including the evidence led on behalf of the prosecution. The aforesaid materials implicate the petitioner in the murder. We are not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner at this stage.

We request the trial court to conclude the trial at the earliest preferably within six months from the next date fixed for the purpose without granting any unnecessary adjournment.

The application for bail, is, thus, rejected.
