According to learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the writ petition may be disposed of by directing respondent No. 2 being the Regional Transport Authority, Paschim Bardhaman to consider the representation and disposed of the same by hearing all concerned parties including the petitioner and by passing a reasoned order in accordance with law.
