Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was falsely implicated.

No specific role can be attributed to the petitioner.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention to the statement of the eye witness recorded under Section 161 of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
