The petitioner is aggrieved that the Central Information Commission has not disposed of a second appeal under the RTI Act, in respect of information sought from the Municipality in question.

Having regard to the submissions made by the parties, this court directs the Central Information Commission to dispose of the second appeal of the petitioner as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of four months from the date of communication of this order.
