Petitioners seek anticipatory bail.

Learned Advocate appearing for the petitioners submits that the de facto complainant tried to commit suicide. The petitioners were falsely implicated.

State and the de facto complainant are represented.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State draws the attention to the materials in the case diary including the injury report of the de facto complainant.

Learned Advocate appearing for the de facto complainant relies upon photographs establishing the nature and extent of the torture that the petitioner meted out to the de facto complainant.

Considering the gravity of the offence and the involvement of the petitioners therein as transpiring from the materials in the case diary, we are unable to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is rejected.

CRM (A) 3544 of 2022 is dismissed.
