In view of the claim of the petitioner that he complied with the order dated October 28, 2021, it would be appropriate to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear before the Court below and pray for regular bail within a period of four weeks from date and on further condition that the petitioner shall meet the Investigating Officer as and when called for till completion of investigation and further that the petitioner shall appear before the jurisdictional Court on every date fixed for hearing.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **allowed.**
