The report and the memo of evidence submitted by the Mr. Aniket Mitra, learned advocate appearing for the State be kept with the record.

The report reflects that all the accused persons have been discharged from the case as the de facto complainant addressed an affidavit to the Officer-in-Charge of the concerned P. S. informing that there has been an amicable settlement between the parties.

Accordingly, the revisional application being CRR 2370 of 2018 is dismissed.
