Md. Kutubuddin, learned advocate appears for the petitioner.

Record shows that the notice of this application has not been served on the opposite parties.

The petitioner by filing the present application under Article 227 of the Constitution of India have prayed for expeditious disposal of the Title Suit No. 73 of 2012, pending before the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), 2nd Court, Rampurhat, Birbhum.

The learned advocate for the petitioner submits that the learned Court below has been granting unnecessary adjournments and due to which, there is a delay in disposal of the case and such delay is causing hardship to the petitioner.
