In Re: - An application for anticipatory bail under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with G.R. Case No.1847 of 2022 arising out of **Bagdah** Police Station Case No. **424 of 2022** dated **08.06.2022** under Sections **143/186/333/353/188/307/341/290/120(B)** of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 read with Section **9** of the M.P.O and Section **3** of the Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984.

Petitioners pray for anticipatory bail on the ground of parity with the other co-accused who was enlarged on anticipatory bail on July 25, 2022 in CRM (A) 3510 of 2022.

Learned Advocate appearing for the State does not dispute the claim for parity.

In such circumstances, we grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on bail upon furnishing a Bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each, with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer and subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on condition that the petitioners will report before the Investigating Officer once a week till the conclusion of the investigation and on condition that the petitioners shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass

appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioners in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Accordingly, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioners is allowed.

C.R.M. (A) 3738 of 2022 is, thus, disposed of.
