Heard the learned Counsels appearing on behalf of the parties.

Petitioner is in custody for about 45 days. He prays for bail.

Learned Advocate for the State opposes the prayer for bail.

We have considered the materials on record. Keeping in mind the nature of allegation, extent of complicity of the petitioner in the crime and as no one was injured, we are of the opinion further detention of the petitioner is not necessary and he may be granted bail.

Accordingly, the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of like amount each, one of whom must be local, to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nadia at Krishnanagar

subject to condition that he shall appear before the trial court on every date of hearing until further orders and shall not intimidate witnesses or tamper with evidence in any manner whatsoever.

In the event the petitioner fails to appear before the Trial Court without any justifiable cause, the trial Court shall be at liberty to cancel his bail in accordance with law without further reference to this Court.

This application for bail is, thus, disposed of.
