A direction to secure expeditious disposal of the Ejectment Suit No.60 of 2015, pending before the learned 5th Civil Judge (Junior Division), at Alipore, South 24 Parganas, is the ultimate relief sought for in this case.

No other point is raised requiring address by this Court.

In view of the nature of order proposed to be made in this case, no prior notice is considered to be necessary.

Service upon the opposite party is thus dispensed with.

Accordingly, learned 5th Civil Judge (Junior Division), at Alipore, South 24 Parganas, is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of the Ejectment Suit referred above, after causing disposal of pending interlocutory application, if there be any, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties

to this case, but without granting any unnecessary adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable.

Petitioner is directed to make communication of this order to the learned court below as well as to the opposite party and his learned advocate in the court below.

With this observation/direction, the revisional application stands disposed of.
