Accordingly, learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), 1st Court, Barasat, North 24 Parganas, in Title Suit No.199 of 2012, is requested to ensure expeditious disposal of interlocutory application under Order 7 Rule 11 C.P.C, expeditiously as possible, providing sufficient opportunity of hearing to either of the parties to this case, but without granting any unnecessary

adjournment, unless it is extremely unavoidable, preferably before the end of April, 2023.
