In re : An Application for **Anticipatory Bail** under Section **438** of the Code of Criminal Procedure in connection with **Gangarampur** Police Station Case No. **308** of **2022** dated **10.06.2022** under Sections **306/34** of the Indian Penal Code and adding Section **498A** of the IPC and Section **3/4** of DP Act.

Leave is granted to the learned advocate-on-record of the petitioner to amend the cause title of the petition.

The marriage between the petitioner and the deceased is claimed to be of 47 years.

The postmortem of the deceased suggests death by committing suicide.

The Court is informed that on a prayer made by the police for adding Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code read with Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act, such provisions were added by an order dated August 10, 2022.

In such circumstances, we are inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, we direct that in the event of arrest the petitioner shall be released on bail upon furnishing a bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties of like amount each, to the satisfaction of the arresting officer and

also be subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the Investigating Officer once in a month till the conclusion of the investigation and on further condition that the petitioner shall appear on every date before the jurisdictional Court on and from the date fixed for appearance of the accused and in default the jurisdictional Court will pass appropriate order to secure the presence of the petitioner in Court including cancelling the anticipatory bail granted without further reference to this Court.

Prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is **allowed**.

CRM (A) 3857 of 2022 is disposed of.
